Matthew 24 Signs of the Ends of The Age

Seatbelts

My dad used to put on his seatbelt as we drove off, holding it in his teeth.

When seat belts became compulsory, many people objected arguing for their freedom. Nowadays there’s been a change of heart and many people don’t need the fact that it’s the law to ensure they belt up – the benefit of seatbelts outweighs the slight inconvenience.

We know that a crash is highly unlikely but possible. And because it’s a possibility we prepare for that eventuality, we make our driving ready for an unlikely event.

Is it a bear or a bush?

On a resilience course, it was shown how the pessimist is more likely to succeed in business.

Imagine yourself in the wild and in the distance, you see a dark spot among the scrub – is it a bear or a bush? Well if you assume it’s a bush and it’s a bear you’re in trouble. However, if you prepare for it being a bear and you’re

right, it is a bear, you take precautions to like run like billy-o; or, if it's a bush and you've lost nothing! Is it a bear or a bush – best be ready for it to be a bear!

## THEY

### Taken away for judgement

In our gospel reading, Matthew likens those who are taken away to those in the days of Noah. Contrary to popular Christian understanding, rather than those taken as the elect going up to heaven, it is those who are taken, the unbelievers who are like those not left in the safety of the ark. They are taken up for judgement. Those left behind are the believers who wait an indeterminate time for the return and rule of Jesus.

### Caught up together in the clouds 1 Thess 4:15-18

*<sup>15</sup> According to the Lord's word, we tell you that we who are still alive, who are left until the coming of the Lord, will certainly not precede those who have fallen asleep. <sup>16</sup> For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. <sup>17</sup> After that, we who are still alive and are left will be*

*caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so, we will be with the Lord forever. <sup>18</sup> Therefore encourage one another with these words.*

The disciples probably had in mind ...

that Jesus would return in their lifetimes – this doubtless gave them an impetus to get on with the job. It might also have stimulated the gospels writers to inspire those who had not experienced the return of their messiah within their generation.

End of the world cults

Throughout history, fundamentalist groups and flamboyant characters have predicted and acted upon end of the world predictions – for example David Koresh and the Waco massacre

The impact of end-of-world certainty can lead to horrific outcomes – not just the abandoning of long term projects but in mass suicides.

What historical events might have contributed to apocalyptic expectations?

AD70 destruction of the temple, fall of Rome, Black death, Oliver Cromwell, the holocaust, Donald Trump?

The thrust of Jesus' analogy of the thief is a sense of urgency.

How do we retain a sense of urgency with the benefit of 2000 years of hindsight? If we believe that rather like a burglary or a car accident, it's unlikely yet possible.

It's possible I might have a crash whilst driving, it's possible but unlikely that your house will be burgled tonight. This retains the sense of urgency that Jesus engenders in the illustrations of those harvesting and marrying either in the days of Noah or in Jesus day – and allows for the possibility that it could all be concluded this very night.

Certain biblical events must take place before Jesus can return. If these have not happened, he cannot return. So, it hinges on whether these events have happened or not.

Black Friday

Brexit – we weren’t exactly prepared as a nation , Trunp – how ready is the Us to accept their new president or to understand the impact.

And if you knew for certain Jesus wasn't coming for centuries...

What's wrong with slacking off?

It belies a failure to understand what God has given – freedom through faith by grace in the death and resurrection of Jesus. 'A license to sin', some have called Christianity – this fails to appreciate that the repentant heart is not a heart that is perfect, not at all – rather the repentant heart is one that has turned and is turning to serve Christ, certainly not a completed work but a work in progress. The desire to become Christ-like brings about transformation and no rules no strict regulations no bit in the teeth of the horse I needed.

## The wisdom of seatbelts

Once people see the wisdom of seatbelts they don't need the law to ensure they comply. Sadly, the use of mobiles while driving has still to bring about a change of heart despite numerous incidents of fatal crashes.

My brother works in forensics and regularly visits burgled house where people have left their wallets and car keys in plain sight downstairs and made it very easy to have their cards stolen – do I still do that yes – have I ever been burgled – no.

Being burgled remains possible but unlikely – we still prepare our houses for the night time by bolting the door, perhaps even setting an alarm. The Rectory was broken into numerous times during Richard Heading's day – thankfully it hasn't happened yet to me but I notice that the alarm is always activated when I leave the house!

What of your own spiritual house – what state is it in? What parts of the house have we left exposed to the corruption and temptation of the world? Perhaps even now, the life God wants for you, to live it to the fullest is being marred or damaged or burgled because we're not prepared for the onslaught or craftiness of evil one.



What could we do to put our house in order in the unlikely but possible event that Jesus will return on 17<sup>th</sup> Dec at 3pm?

Why would we not want to put our house in order anyway?

4. Have you ever felt it's not worth committing to a long-term project – what are the negative consequences of that line of argument?
5. What difference Christ's returning on Dec 17<sup>th</sup> at 3pm – what might you attempt to resolve – what aspects of your life might you want to address and why?
